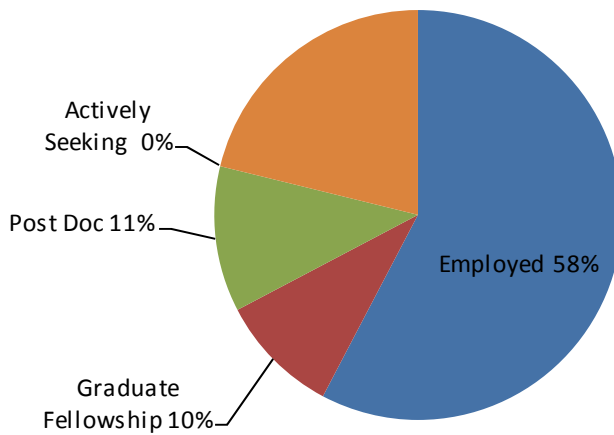

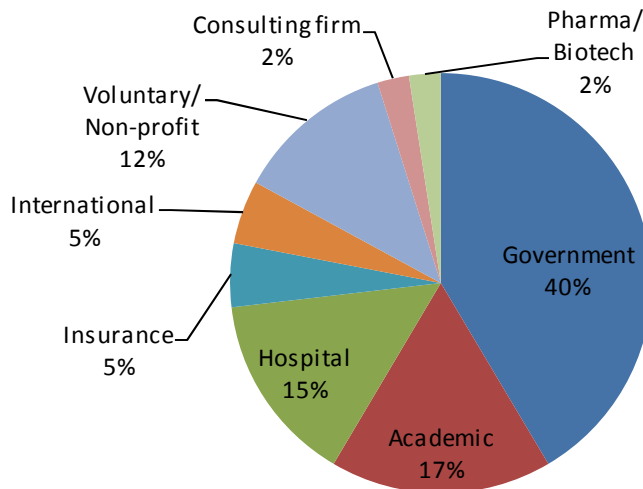


Postgraduate Activities
