1. A document of no more than 3 pages that details:
  - a. Whether the focus of the internship is research or implementation of other work
  - b. Background, public health context, scientific justification for the proposed work

  - h. A description of the preceptor and any organizations involved
2. Correspondence that displays the commitment, invitation, or permission of the proposed host organization(s).
3. Any other documents relating to your proposed internship (brochures, internship job description, cites to relevant literature, etc.)
4. Your resume
5. Your unofficial transcript (available through Wolverine Access)
6. A copy of your financial aid statement (available through Wolverine Access)
7. Any other supporting materials (e.g. budget sources)
